Joined MK Airlines as their representative in Zambia – MK a cargo airline with DC8 freighter aircraft and latterly B747 freighters.

2005 Joined Maersk – the largest container shipping company in the world as the Zambia manager. Set up office in Lusaka with 5 staff then transferred to Safmarine (Maersk subsidiary). 2008 Retired from Safmarine
